First prize went to the film “Peace and Okinawa.”

All six films were interesting in their own ways. They tried to explore deep and important themes. The winning film “Peace and Okinawa” directed by Kinjyo Satoru dealt with an important issue, the problem of Okinawa. As 75 years have passed since the end of War, the memory of the war has been fading out of people’s mind. The film shows that it is important for us to tell the meaning of peace to younger generation. Those who watch the film probably think about the war and hope for peace.

Second prize went to “My Dream.” “My Dream,” directed by Tom Smith, is a film about an Australian boy who hears a voice telling him: “If you dream peace, it will come.” I was very surprised to see the boy’s rabbit tell him to dream peace.

The film “Ask” won third prize. It is a drama film directed by Ann Lee. The main actor cries in the film, “I hope we can have true international friendships. The goal is peace!” The film was very exciting.
